2) Suppose you were on the United Nations committee drafting the "Universal Declaration of Human Rights." What specific rights would you want to include for women? Why? Write a brief explanation of why you would include each of these rights.

3) What provisions would you include for enforcement of these rights? Explain your views. In your opinion, should countries that honor these rights, usually the industrialized western nations, intervene to protect the human rights of women in countries where they remain second-class citizens?
